State Policy Options to Address Rural Health Challenges

Telehealth



Expand telehealth services by providing assistance to rural providers for start-up costs, increasing telehealth coverage and payment, and upgrading broadband access in rural areas.

Payment and Service Delivery Models



Test new payment and service delivery models, such as the Pennsylvania Rural Health Model,¹ which pays rural hospitals on a global budget.

Rural Medical Education Training



Provide opportunities for resident placement in rural communities and enhanced support of graduate medical education.

Transportation



Develop systems to ensure adequate patient transportation to, from, and between institutions regionally.

Hospital Stabilization Fund

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Create a hospital stabilization fund to provide financial support, such as below-market-interest-rate loans, for rural hospitals.

Healthcare Districts



Create healthcare districts as taxing and governance entity for communities that may not be able to sustain services independently.
