

Pregnancy Risk Factors

PRENATAL CARE IN FIRST TRIMESTER

For every 100 new Arkansas moms¹ in 2021, 84 began prenatal care in the first trimester of pregnancy.




The percentage of new Arkansas moms who began prenatal care in the first trimester of pregnancy increased 4 percentage points between 2016 and 2021.²




UNINSURED STATUS

For every 100 new Arkansas moms in 2021, 1 had no insurance during pregnancy.



The percentage of new Arkansas moms with no insurance during pregnancy **remained stable** between 2016 and 2021.


Pregnancy Risk Factors

INTENDED PREGNANCY


For every 100 new Arkansas moms¹ in 2021, **54 had an intended pregnancy**.



The percentage of new Arkansas moms with an intended pregnancy increased 2.7 percentage points between 2016 and 2021.²



For every 100 new Arkansas moms in 2021, 10 smoked cigarettes during the last three months of pregnancy.



CIGARETTE USE

The percentage of new Arkansas moms who smoked cigarettes during the last three months of pregnancy decreased 5.6 percentage points between 2016 and 2021.


Pregnancy Risk Factors

DEPRESSION

For every 100 new Arkansas moms¹ in 2021, **25 reported experiencing depression** during pregnancy.



The percentage of new Arkansas moms who reported experiencing depression during pregnancy increased 3.8 percentage points between 2016 and 2021.²




INTIMATE PARTNER VIOLENCE

For every 100 new Arkansas moms in 2021, 3 reported experiencing intimate partner violence during pregnancy.



The percentage of new Arkansas moms who reported experiencing intimate partner violence during pregnancy increased less than 1 percentage point between 2016 and 2021.




Pregnancy Risk Factors

DENTAL CARE

For every 100 new Arkansas moms¹ in 2021, 41 had their teeth cleaned by a dentist or dental hygienist during pregnancy.




The percentage of new Arkansas moms who had their teeth cleaned by a dentist or dental hygienist during pregnancy increased 5.1 percentage points between 2016 and 2021.²




BODY MASS INDEX (BMI) IN THE OVERWEIGHT OR OBESE RANGE

For every 100 new Arkansas moms in 2021, 60 had a BMI in the overweight or obese range.



The percentage of new Arkansas moms with a BMI in the overweight or obese range increased 5.4 percentage points between 2016 and 2021.
