
Trends Among Public High School Seniors

SOLD ILLEGAL DRUGS

For every 100 public high school seniors in 2023, **2** reported selling illegal drugs in the past year.¹




The percentage of public high school seniors who sold illegal drugs in the past year decreased 2.4 percentage points from 2018 to 2023.



WERE DRUNK OR HIGH AT SCHOOL

For every 100 public high school seniors in 2023, 8 reported being drunk or high at school in the past year.¹



The percentage of public high school seniors who were drunk or high at school in the past year **decreased 3.4 percentage** points from 2018 to 2023.







Trends Among Public High School Seniors

For every 100 public high school seniors in 2023, **5 reported carrying a handgun** in the past year.¹




The percentage of public high school seniors who carried a handgun in the past year **decreased 0.1 percentage** points from 2018 to 2023.



ATTACKED SOMEONE WITH INTENT TO HARM

The percentage of public high school seniors who attacked someone with intent to harm in the past year **decreased 1.2 percentage** points from 2018 to 2023.






Trends Among Public High School Seniors

WERE SUSPENDED FROM SCHOOL


For every 100 public high school seniors in 2023, 10 reported that they had been suspended from school in the past year.¹

USED ALCOHOL


The percentage of public high school seniors who used alcohol in the past 30 days decreased 7.8 percentage points from 2018 to 2023.






Trends Among Public High School Seniors

For every 100 public high school seniors in 2023, 3 reported using cigarettes in the past 30 days.¹




For every 100 public high school seniors in 2023, 14 reported vaping nicotine at least once in the past 30 days.¹

VAPED NICOTINE


The percentage of public high school seniors who vaped nicotine at least once in the past 30 days **decreased 3.3 percentage** points from 2020^a to 2023.







For every 100 public high school seniors in 2023, 11 reported using marijuana in the past 30 days.1






The percentage of public high school seniors who used marijuana in the past 30 days decreased 3.5 percentage points from 2018 to 2023.







USED INHALANTS

For every 100 public high school seniors in 2023, 2 reported using inhalants at least once in their lifetime.¹




The percentage of public high school seniors who used inhalants at least once in their lifetime^a decreased 1.4 percentage points from 2018 to 2023.



WFRF FIFCTRONICALLY BULLIFD:

For every 100 public high school seniors in 2023, 19 reported being electronically bullied at least once in the past year.²



The percentage of public high school seniors who were electronically bullied at least once in the past year increased 2.6 percentage points from 2015 to 2023.





Trends Among Public High School Seniors

FELT SAD OR HOPELESSa

For every 100 public high school seniors in 2023, 60 reported feeling sad or hopeless almost every day for two or more weeks in a row in the past year.²




The percentage of public high school seniors who felt sad or hopeless for two or more weeks in a row in the past year **increased 33.1 percentage points** from 2015 to 2023.



SERIOUSLY CONSIDERED SUICIDE

For every 100 public high school seniors in 2023, 34 reported seriously considering attempting suicide in the past year.²



The percentage of public high school seniors who seriously considered attempting suicide in the past year **increased 16.3 percentage** points from 2015 to 2023.
