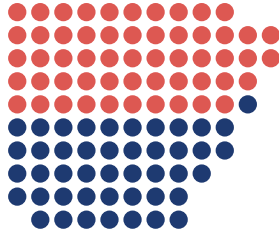

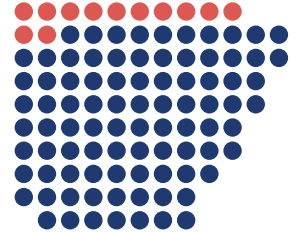
SEX¹

- 45 are male



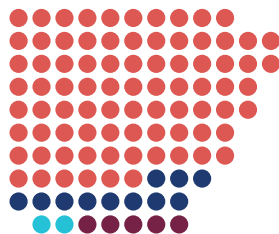
POVERTY¹

- 88 do not



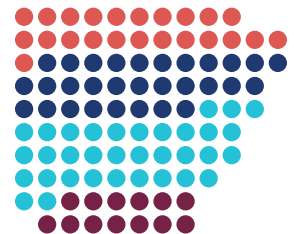
RACE¹

- 5 are of multiple races



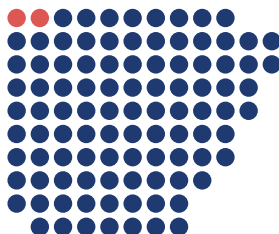
EDUCATION²

ETHNICITY¹

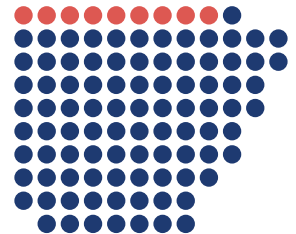
- 2 are Hispanic or Latino

FOOD INSECURITY³

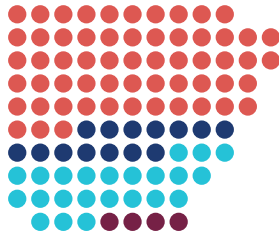
Among seniors age 60 or older

- 91 are not



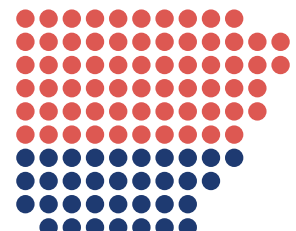
MARITAL STATUS²

- 34 report fair or poor health



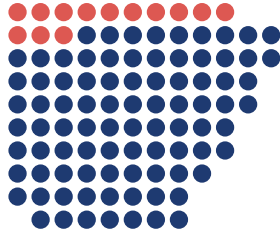

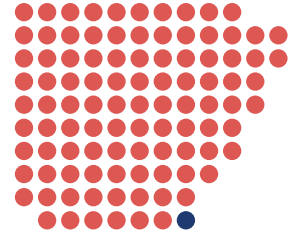
SMOKING²

- 87 do not



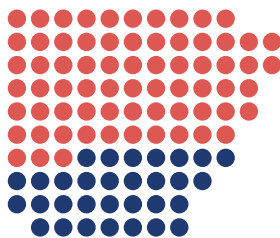
HEALTH COVERAGE¹

- 1 does not



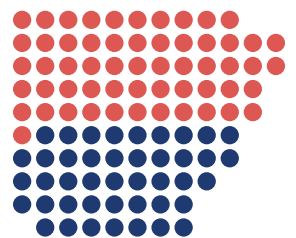
OVERWEIGHT OR OBESITY²

- 31 do not



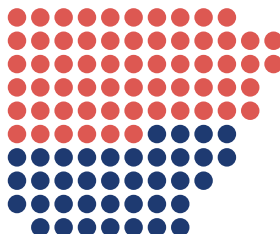
DENTAL VISIT²

- 43 did not



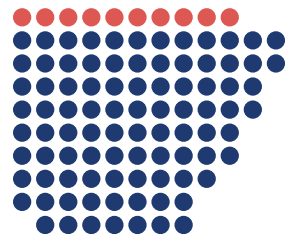
EXERCISE²

- 38 did not



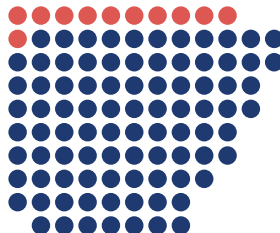
ASTHMA²

- 90 do not



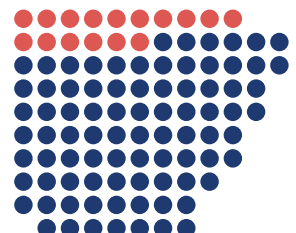
FREQUENT MENTAL DISTRESS²
