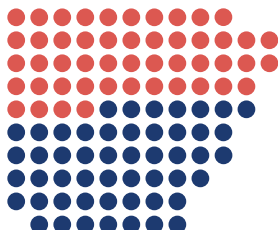

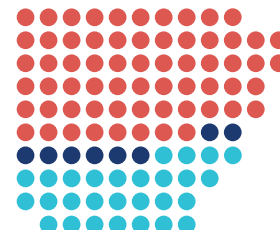
GENDER¹

HOUSEHOLD¹

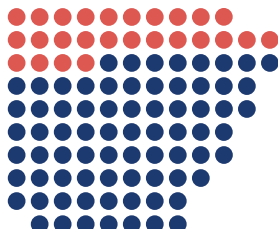
- 64 live in a married couple household

NOTE: Children in non-family households not included.

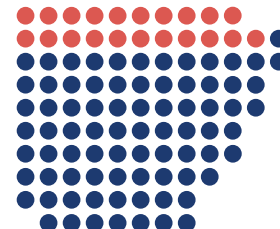
AGE¹

- 74 are age 5-17



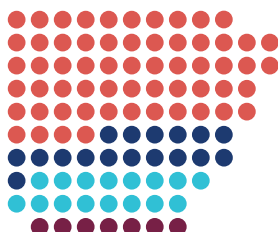
POVERTY¹

- 79 do not



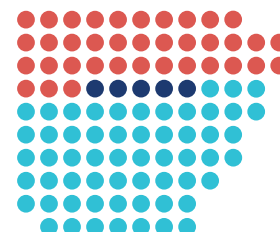
RACE¹

SCHOOL LUNCH²

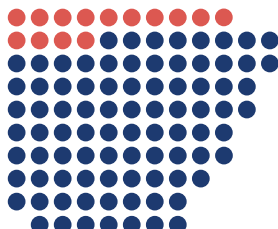
- 37 qualify for free lunch

NOTE: Among public school students only. Under 656 of 2023, students who qualify for reduced-price lunch pay nothing.

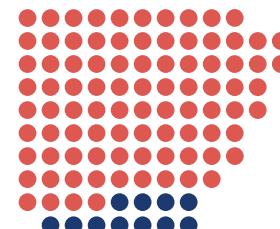
ETHNICITY¹

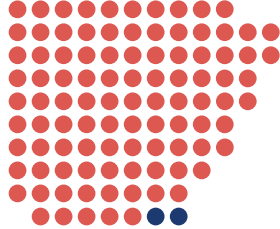

HEALTH STATUS⁴

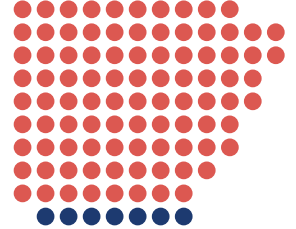
- 98 report good or better health

HEALTH COVERAGE⁵

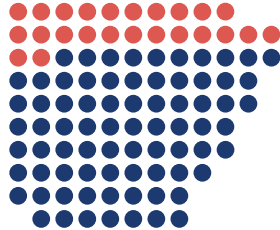
- 93 have health coverage

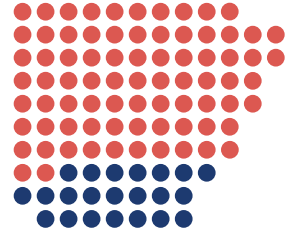
FOOD INSECURITY⁶

- 22 did not

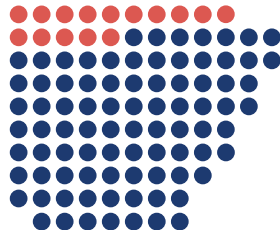


VAPING⁷

- 85 do not

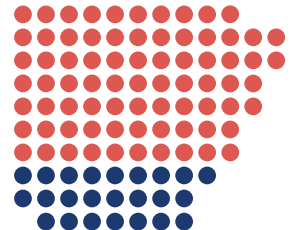

Among children age 0-35 months

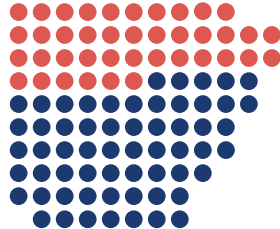
- 76 have appropriate immunizations

Among children age 6-17

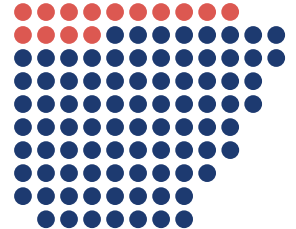
- 40 have overweight or obesity
